

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Information about this competition ("Competition") form part of these conditions of entry. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry. Only entries, which are submitted and comply with these conditions of entry, may take part in this Competition.
2. The promoter is Mylan NZ Limited of 2b George Bourke Drive, Mount Wellington, Auckland, New Zealand 1060 ("Promoter"). The promoter's telephone number is 09 579 2792.
3. Entry is open only to New Zealand residents over the age of 16. Employees and their immediate families of the Promoter and its agencies and companies associated in any way with this competition are ineligible.
4. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify Entrants who provide false information during the entry process.
5. This Competition commences on 1st October 2010 at 5:00am NZST and concludes on 30th November 2010 at 5.00pm NZST.
6. All completed entries must be received by mail, no later than 5.00pm NZST on 8th December 2010. No late entries will be considered. The Promoter is not responsible for any late, misdirected, delayed, undelivered or lost entries. All entries become the property of the promoter.
7. This Competition is a game of chance. Subject to these Terms and Conditions, all Entrants will be eligible to win the Competition.
8. To enter, Eligible Entrants must:
 - a. Purchase any specifically marked Swisse product(s) during the promotional period
 - b. Fully complete the entry form available at the point of sale and send complete with original proof of purchase to "Swisse \$100,000 promotion, PO Box 11183, Ellerslie, Auckland 1542.
9. One entry per product per person only.
10. Each individual entry must be received on a separate entry form. One proof of purchase showing multiple differing product purchases is acceptable providing each individual entry is on a separate entry form, and all entries evidenced by that proof of purchase are submitted together in the same envelope.
11. Weekly product prize draws will be randomly drawn at 5:00pm NZST every Friday commencing 8th October 2010 and concluding on 3rd December 2010. There will be up to 100 product prize draws each week. All winners will be notified by telephone, post or email shortly thereafter. All eligible entries will be placed in the final draw.
12. The final draw will take place on the 10th December 2010 at 10am NZST at Edge Loyalty, 2 Picton Street, Ponsonby, Auckland 1011. The first valid entry drawn will win the opportunity to play the Game for the chance to win NZD100,000.
13. The Winner will be required to sign a consent agreement and declaration of validity of entry before the start of the Game as a condition of accepting the prize.

14. The Game will take place at a pre-determined neutral venue in Auckland on the 17th December 2010. The promoter will liaise with the drawn Winner to organise travel from the New Zealand airport nearest to the Winner, to and from Auckland including one night's accommodation (if required) and specified meals for two.
